

National Dong Hwa University Scholarship Regulations for Overseas Chinese Students

Approved by the 2nd Administrative Council in 2nd semester of the Academic Year 2021/2022 on March 16th, 2022

Article 1 This university specifically establishes these regulations for the purpose of continuous promotion of internationalization and international student recruitment, attraction of preeminent overseas Chinese students to the university and encouragement for students with excellent moral and academic performance to study in the university.

Article 2 Overseas Chinese students referred to in these guidelines shall mean and refer to overseas Chinese students, Hong Kong or Macao students or overseas Chinese students living in Hong Kong or Macao with foreign nationality who have met with requirements of “Regulations regarding study and counseling assistance for overseas Chinese students in Taiwan” and “Guidelines governing Hong Kong or Macao residents studying in Taiwan.”

Article 3 Application Eligibility

1. Students with official student status (excluding deferred study students) in this school without receiving this school’s punishment more serious than reprimand (included) during their study.

Note: Qualification for receiving scholarship (including exemption of tuition and receiving of living allowance): until 4th year for undergraduate class, 2nd year for graduate class and 4th year for Ph.D. class. No scholarships will be awarded and students will have to pay for various fees as required for study exceeding aforementioned years.

2. For undergraduate students, academic performance for previous semester shall rank among top 35% of classes in their departments with conduct grades reaching more than 80 points.
3. For graduate students, academic performance for previous semester shall rank among top 35% of classes in their departments with conduct grades reaching more than 80 points.
4. For students without academic performance for previous semester because they are in the period of writing master’s and doctoral thesis:
These students may present their thesis writing plans and file for application within the school’s application deadline. Thesis writing

plan shall include research motive and purpose, research structure and design, data collection measures and sources, summary of thesis, reference books or academic paper publications, and so on.

5. For students of 5-year program for BA and MA degree, or students with direct admissions to master or Ph.D. degree, academic performances throughout the years in master or Ph.D. classes can be utilized for application hereto.

Article 4 Quota and Type

1. Quota for Scholarships: Total number of recipients shall depend on annual budget of that specific year.
2. Types of Scholarship:
 - (1) Undergraduate
 - a. Exemption of Tuition and Fees: (Standards for exemption of tuition and fees shall be based on the university' announcement.)
 - b. Living Allowances: NTD4,000 each month during the semester when scholarship is received.
 - (2) Graduate School
 - a. Exemption of Tuition and Fees: (Standards for exemption of tuition and fees shall be based on the university' announcement.)
 - b. Living Allowances: NTD6,000 each month during the semester when scholarship is received.

Article 5 Application Measures

1. Newly admitted students: Admission documents prepared during application to study at the university will be utilized for review standards.
2. Current Students: The following materials shall be submitted for application within deadline announced by Office of International Affairs during opening of each semester:
 - (1) Application form for this scholarship (mandatory)
 - (2) Official copy of academic performance for previous semester (mandatory)
 - (3) Ranking percentage in the whole class for previous semester (mandatory)
 - (4) Other supporting materials for review: (For instance, teacher's recommendation letter, competition award certificate, extra-

curricular cadre proof, presentation of academic paper, and so on.) (optional)

Article 6 Measures of Review

Review will be conducted by the review team, which is composed of this university's director of Office of International Affairs and respective team heads of Office of International Affairs, based on application student's high school academic performance, performance rankings in the class for previous semester, recommendation letter and other supporting materials for the review. Scholarships will be awarded to applicants with excellent performance, and the list of scholarship recipients will be submitted to the Principal of the University for Approval.

Article 7 Scholarship Awarding Requirements and Measures

1. Period for receiving scholarship is one semester. Current students need to re-apply for scholarships each semester.
2. In the event of approved recipient for living allowance, receiving periods are for the first semester (from September to January next year) and the second semester (from February to June) respectively. Office of International Affairs will remit allowances to approved scholarship recipient's account in local bank or post office each month during scholarship receiving period in accordance with reviewed recipient list.

Article 8 Approved scholarship recipients shall comply with the following requirements and obligations

1. Recipients shall complete registration procedures within deadline prescribed by the university.
2. In the event of withdrawal from school, the recipient's qualification will be revoked and scholarship will be terminated from the next month after leaving school.
3. In the event of suspension of study, scholarship will be suspended from the next month after leaving school. Recipients will have to re-apply within deadline for the semester when study is resumed.
4. For freshmen winning scholarship but applying for reservation of admission qualification, their scholarship-winning qualification shall not be reserved except for special incidents approved by scholarship review team.

5. Review units may adjust contents for a student's scholarship in the event that aforementioned requirements are not satisfied.

Article 9 In the event that an approved scholarship recipient is found to be engaged in forged or false materials or duplicated claims of scholarship, the winning qualification will be revoked and scholarship received shall be returned accordingly.

Article 10 Matters not prescribed in regulations hereto shall be handled in accordance with related requirements of the university or Ministry of Education.

Article 11 Regulations hereto are passed by Administration Meeting and is implemented after approval from the Principal.
