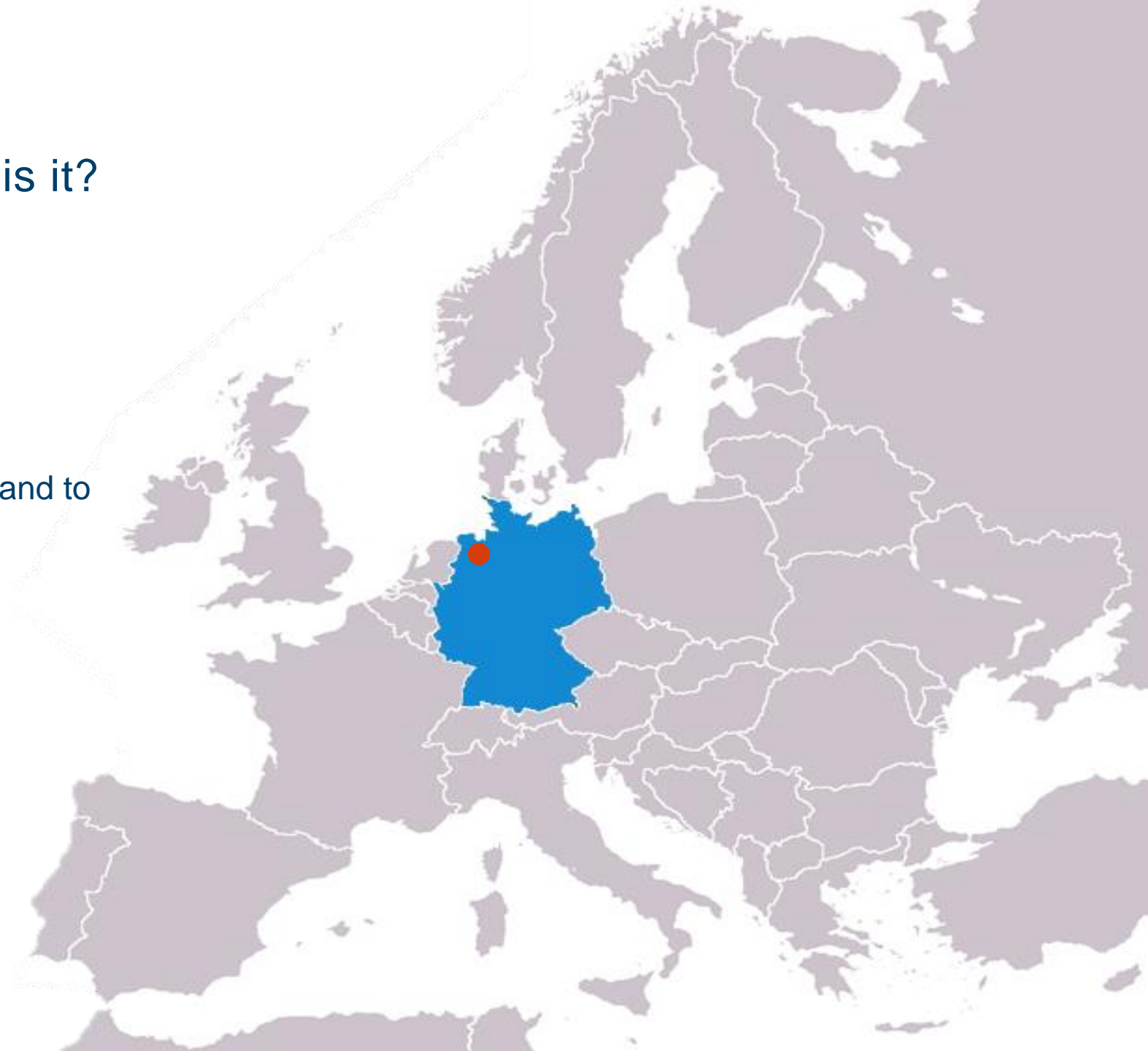

European Studies in Global Perspectives (EuGI)

- key aspects in European societies, economies, and cultures, both present and past
 - Cluster 1 Society, Economy, and Politics
 - Cluster 2: Languages, Cultures, and Education
- English is main language of instruction (B2 level required)
- German language course included
- 1 or 2 semesters
- Minimum 24 credit points (CP) per semester
- Certificate after successful completion

How to become an exchange student in Oldenburg

- Apply for the exchange programme at your home university
→ nomination
- Fill in the application documents we send you
→ letter of acceptance
- Prepare a learning agreement (which courses?)
- Fill in online enrolment documents
→ enrolment
- Come to Oldenburg
→ Welcome Week for international students
→ Study

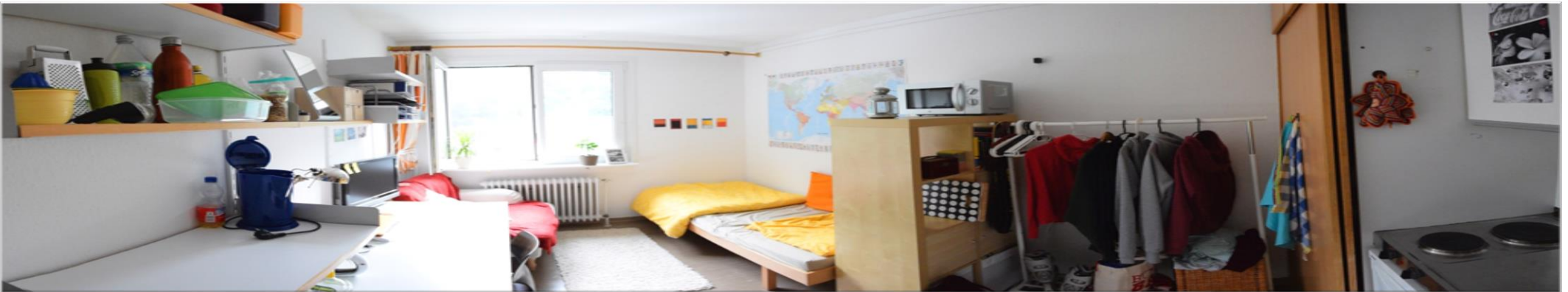
