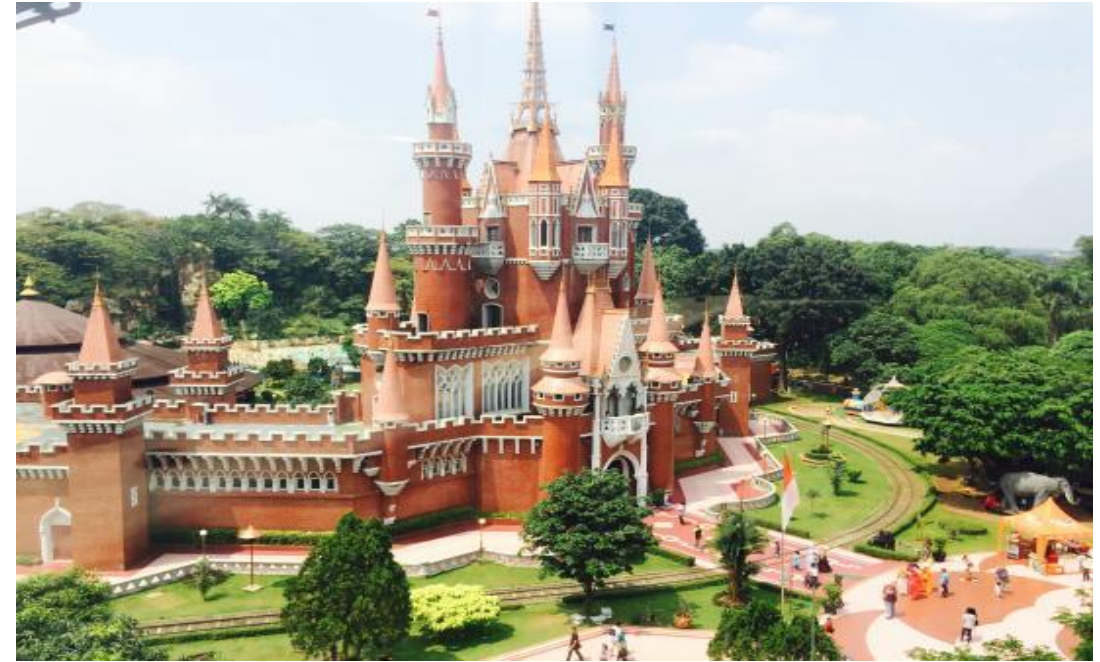

Kota Lama consists of several areas that come with a distinct nuance. The good thing is tourists can explore them all freely. Most of the buildings apply the Dutch architecture.



The Sam Poo Kong Temple, also known as Gedong Batu (the Stone Building), is the oldest Chinese temple in Semarang. Unlike most temples, the building does not belong to any specific religion, but rather functions as a place of worship for people of various ethnicities and religious groups including Buddhists, Taoists and Muslims.



SOLO

Solo, or sometimes known as Surakarta, is a city in Central Java that still strongly adheres to its Javanese roots. You can still find various heritage buildings, including the majestic Surakarta Palace. The city is known as the center of batik, many shops selling handcrafted batik are available for you to check out too.



BANDUNGAN

Candi Gedong Songo is a complex of small Hindu temples. It consists of nine temples, scattered in the slope of Ungaran mountain.
